Last Friday we finished our 'All About Me' topic with a teddy bears' picnic. The children made cupcakes, sandwiches and squash. They were very excited and had a wonderful time.

This week we have been learning about autumn. We listened to the story 'We're going on a leaf hunt' and we talked about seasonal changes. The children created their own stories about autumn based on this week's story.

In phonics we have been learning the sounds 't-t-t-' and 'i-i-i'. We focused on reading CVC words made out of the sounds we already know such as sad, dad, at, mat and did. Please keep practicing at home with your child.

In maths we have been learning one more and one less than the numbers 1, 2 and 3. The children used their fingers, objects and numbers to show one more and one less.

In Understanding the world, we explored autumn fruits, leaves, conkers, acorns and pinecones. We learned the names of different trees such as maple, oak, hickory and birch and looked at each tree leaves to identify them.

The children showed interest in making an apple pie after pretending to make their apple pies out of playdough! We talked about what ingredients we needed to make an apple pie and each step of the recipe. Then the children made their own individual apple pies. They were yummy!

In Forest school this week, we had the fun job of looking after the school animals. We have been feeding the chickens, collecting the eggs, and visiting the guinea pigs to deliver tasty treats.
