This term we are learning about 'Transport'. We introduced a bar graph to discuss how the children travel to school and we found that most children walk to school.

We listened to the story 'Rosie's Walk' and used positional language to describe Rosie's position in different parts of the story.

In phonics we have been learning the sounds 'nnnn' and 'p-p-p'. We focused on reading CVC words and captions made out of the sounds we already know such as 'dad is mad', 'I am sad', 'a pin and a tin'. Please keep practicing at home with your child and write a comment on their reading diaries.

In maths we have been learning number bonds to three. The children used blocks, numicon, fingers and counters to make numbers 1, 2 and 3. We listened to the story 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' and began to solve number problems within the story.

The children loved changing the role-play area into a bus. Then they pretended to sell Oyster cards, they lined up at the bus stop and took turns to be the bus driver.

This week in Forest school, the children have been learning about some of the trees in our woodland area. We also worked collaboratively to come up with ideas of how we could make a swing, which was great fun!
