This week we listened to the story 'The Train Ride'. Most children are very confident answering questions about the story and drawing a story map to retell it. When drawing their story maps most children attempted to use their phonics knowledge to write words such as 'train', 'sheep' and 'cow'.

We introduced the vocabulary underground and passenger and discussed what they mean. Throughout the week, we encouraged the children to use these words during their play.

In Phonics, we learnt the sounds 'f' and 'e' and the tricky word 'no'. As your child learns more sounds and words it is important to read at home every day with your child and write a comment in their reading diaries every time you listen to them. If your child finds it tricky to blend, please play oral blending games at home (watch the oral blending video on Tapestry). In maths, we have been learning all about the number five. We explored different ways to represent the number five using cubes, objects, numicon and numerals. We also used a number frame to investigate one more and one less than five.


During our circle time, we have been talking about Advent and the children have been opening our class advent. Every day the children are encouraged to do an act of kindness from our advent calendar.

The children have been engaging in independent writing and reading during continuous provision.

In Forest School, we introduced the children to fire lighting skills. When they noticed that rubbing two sticks together did not work, the children were introduced to flint and steel to make a spark.
