10th December 2020

This week, to end our transport topic, we listened to the story 'Whatever Next'. We discussed how the little bear was pretending to go to the moon and what resources he used to make a rocket and a space suit.

We looked at pictures of the moon and planets in space. We identified Earth as the planet where we live. We enjoyed drawing pictures of space, planets, meteors and rockets and some attempted to write key words using their phonics knowledge.

We introduced the vocabulary 'space' and 'astronaut' and discussed what they mean. Throughout the week, we encouraged the children to use these words during their play.

In Phonics, we learnt the sounds 'l' and 'h' and the tricky word 'so'. As your child learns more sounds and words it is important to read at home every day with your child and write a comment in their reading diaries every time you listen to them. If your child finds it tricky to blend, please play oral blending games at home (watch the oral blending video on Tapestry). In maths, we have been learning about squares and rectangles. We used the words corners, equal, long and short to describe the shapes and to distinguish between squares and rectangles. We also learned a song about shapes!

During our circle time, we have been looking at our Christmas decorations and we enjoyed talking about how we celebrate Christmas. The children learned new Christmas traditions as everyone celebrates Christmas in a different way.

During continuous provision, we enjoyed wrapping presents, designing toys and writing letters to Santa in our Santa's workshop area.
