Dear Parents and Carers,

On Sunday 29th November the government, very belatedly, made a decision to update guidance with regard to the Christmas period. This included the possibility of audiences attending school events such as nativities in tier 2 areas, subject to appropriate safeguards. This is in contrast to their 'rule of 6'.

As the need to socially distance would still be compulsory, it would be impossible for us to achieve fair and equitable access for parents, without the need to repeat the performance numerous times. This is simply neither fair nor practical given the other restrictions and procedures we are also having to adhere to currently.

Inviting any audience members onto our site would be incompatible with our COVID-Secure risk assessment. As such, we will be proceeding with the plans which we had agreed before this very late change to DfE guidance.

We look forward to sending out the Christmas videos and know that they will bring you joy. They are being recorded next week so please take note so the children can bring their Christmas jumpers and hats.
