Break the Rules Day!

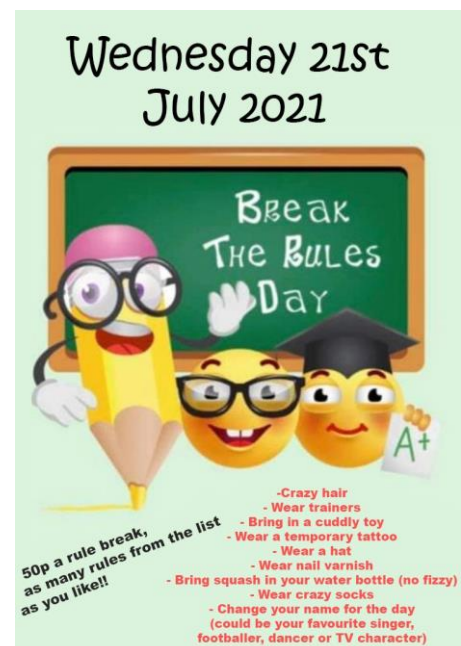
The PA are excited to announce CPS' first 'Break the Rules Day'.

Club4 Programme

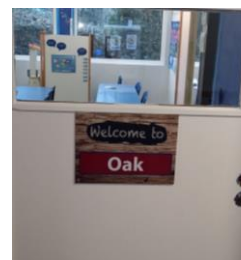
