Addendum to behaviour policy
Active from 01.06.20

Parents and carers who have;

- Chosen to send their child/ren back to school in line with government guidelines
- Or send their child/ren as part of CPS care for keyworkers

Must be supportive of the following, additional behaviour expectations put in place to ensure the safety of staff and children. Parents and carers must ensure their child has a clear age-appropriate understanding prior to them attending school.

Every child must:

- Tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- Follow CPS instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitisation
- Follow instructions on social distancing and remaining within their bubble
- Maintain social distancing at home following government guidelines
- Move around the school following guidelines set out e.g. keeping two metre distance and observing one way systems
- Follow expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal (catch it, bin it, kill it) or in crook of arm
- Avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes with their hands
- Follow rules regarding use of equipment
- Use their 'bubble toilet' at specific times as directed by their bubble leader
- Follow clear boundaries with staff – no close physical contact (hugging for example)
- Not bring in any unauthorised items from home
- Demonstrate CPS Values
- Year 6 may bring a mobile phone to school if they are walking alone. This must be switched off on arrival and will be stored at the child's learning station. CPS accepts no responsibility for the safe keeping of your child's phone
- Not wear any jewellery including watches

Children who are not following our SCARRF values or any other safety aspects of this behaviour policy will not be able to attend school. If behaviour values are not followed then a call will be made home for parent/carer collection within an appropriate timescale

Child Friendly Version:

- I will wash my hands:
 - when I arrive at school
 - when asked to do so by an adult
 - before and after eating
 - after playtimes

- I will only play with my bubble friends

- I will stay in my classroom at all times. I will
 - only leave to go to the toilet
 - always use the same entrance and exit
 - not enter the hall, office area or medical room, unless asked to do so by an adult

- I will tell my bubble teacher if I feel unwell
- I will not share my pencils, food, drink or any other equipment that has been given to me
- I will only use the toilet assigned to my bubble
- I know that my teacher will not be able to hug, carry, hold my hand. I will think of a fun way of doing a 'virtual hug' at a distance which I will share with my teacher!
- I will not bring in anything from home other than my water bottle and lunch.
- I will follow the CPS SCARRF Values at all times
