This week we focused our learning on police officers and how they help us. The children listened to the story 'Police Officer' and learned a song about police officers. The children loved the visit of a police officer and trying on his hat!

We also talked about Remembrance and the children enjoyed painting poppies, making playdough poppies and watching a Remembrance clip.

In Mini-Woodies, the children made magic potions. The children developed their imagination and language skills through an exciting and fun activity.

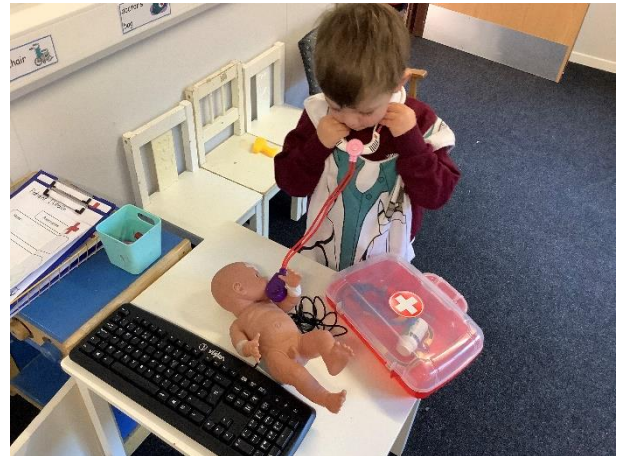
