This week we have been learning all about pets. We listened to the story 'Dear Zoo' and discussed our experiences of having pets, how some animals live at home with humans. Furthermore, some of the children have shared their lovely photos with their pets and were delighted to share pet names. We enjoyed joining reception in the afternoon during outdoor play, the children were very excited to use the reception equipment and play with everyone as one phase.
