Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you had a healthy and joyous festive time and a relaxing break. Team CPS would like to wish all of our community a Happy New Year! I cannot believe it is 2022! It was lovely seeing all of the children return, eager to share all of their Christmas news and holiday activities, looking smart and ready to learn.

We welcome Ms Tamimi back to school after her maternity leave; she has had several 'Keeping in Touch' days and is excited to be leading the Nursery, working with Miss Dias and the whole Early Years Team. We also have several new support staff joining us this term to work across the school.

We are looking forward to a successful Spring Term. Cases of Covid continue within our community and we endeavour to mitigate the risk as far as we are able, following both local and national guidance. Cases at CPS are low amongst children, however we do have several staff absent.

Our year has begun with some valuable staff training. Teachers, led by Mr Godfrey our Computing Lead, reflected on our computing curriculum, our vision and the importance of assessment in this important subject. The EYFS team ensured all subject leads are aware of the new EYFS framework introduced in September and changes to assessment. We looked at Learning Journeys and watched videos sharing examples of high quality provision and learning taking place across this phase. SLT also met with teachers to discuss children and their progress.

Several staff had a busy day focussing on mental health training. Adam Morris, a qualified cognitive behavioural therapist led the morning session; his passion for inspiring, educating and helping others to overcome problems and develop positive mental health was practical and informative. He focused on reducing the stigma attached to mental health and building resilience and coping skills. The afternoon session, delivered by Natasha Devon MBE, shared her insights and research on mental health, body image, gender and equality. This training will be cascaded across the team.
