Friends of Claygate Primary School

What are we?

A Registered Charity, Registered Charity No. 1172759, which was set up in 2017 to provide additional resources to enhance the educational experience of children at Claygate Primary School. School budgets are increasingly stretched, so the need for further support from regular contributions from parents is ever more critical.

We have an online donation system via the Charity Aid Foundation. We ask you to make a voluntary contribution of £15 per month per child, with £30 for two or more children. If you are a tax payer, you can get tax relief if you donate through Gift Aid. This also allows us to claim basic rate tax of 20% on your donation, at no cost to yourself. The suggested contribution has not increased since it was established in 2017.

How are donations used?

Contributions from parents are making a significant difference :

In 2021-2022, it has enabled the school to purchase:

- IT equipment for each year group with Chrome books and charging trollies
- Expansion of the Accelerated reader, Little Wandle Phonics and Voice 21 programmes
- Themed displays in the corridors and the Hall
- Staff training.
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In 2022-23, plans are in place to support improvements in

- Design and Technology facilities
- Outdoor play areas
- A Sensory Pod
- History, Geography and RE project activities.
