

EYFS Newsletter

8th June 2022

The children were excited to be back at school after a restful half term. We began our 'Seaside' topic and the children enjoyed showing their seaside photos to their teachers and friends. The children shared their seaside experiences and we then talked about where the seaside is and what features can we find at the seaside.

During continuous provision, the children explored their new seaside role-play areas and topic resources. The children wore flip-flops, played with empty sun cream bottles, pretended to buy ice creams at the seaside café and enjoyed seaside related water play.

Nursery

In English, the children explored a non-fiction book about the beach. They learned topic related vocabulary such as shallow, seaweed, shells, sandpipers, sun cream and life guard. Blue Acorns drew pictures of the beach and used full sentences to describe their pictures. Red Acorns focused their learning on comprehension questions and speaking in full sentences.

In Phonics, the children played games to develop their listening skills and to support them listening to initial sounds in words.

In Mathematics, the children explored a feely bag to find 2D shapes. They also found 2D shapes in the environment and counted how many sides each shape has.

In Mini-Woodies, the children explored the mini-woodland area to find signs of summer. The children discussed their findings and the summer season.

Reception

In English, the children listened to the non-fiction book 'On the Beach' and discussed what they can find in rock pools. The children wrote sentences about the seaside and what they can see at the beach.

In Phonics, the children continue to learn phase 4 CVCC words and CCVC words with long vowel sounds such as growl, steep, joint and toast. This term the children will be reviewing all tricky words taught so far and secure spelling.


In Mathematics, the children have been learning about doubling. The children listened to the story 'Doubling the Ducks' and used concrete resources to find the double of numbers up to 10.





In Mini-Woodies, the children have been making their own sea creatures using natural resources they have found in the woodland area. The children used sticks, stones and leaves to create starfish, crabs, fish and octopuses.
