This week the Blue Acorns had their last stay and play sessions in Reception and Reception children had their meet the teacher transition session.

Red Acorns had a lovely Teddy Bears' Picnic and met some of their new friends.

Nursery

In English, the children listened to the story 'Three Little Fish and the Big Bad Shark'. The children loved the familiarity of the story and learning facts about sharks.

In Phonics, the children played games to support their oral blending CVC, CCVC and CCVCC words such as p-a-t, c-l-a-p, s-t-a-m-p.

In Mathematics, the children have been using key words such as big, medium, small, same and different to sort objects by size and/or colour.

Reception

In English, the children listened to the story 'Smiley Shark' and wrote fact sheets about sharks using their phonics knowledge.

The children also discussed going to Year 1 and created their Reception memory books. The children enjoyed looking at photos of the beginning of their school year and recalling their past experiences.

In Phonics, the children learned words ending in **er** and **est** such as jumper, printer, softest, plumpest and freshest. The children reviewed the tricky words **to**, **into**, **all**, **are**, **they**, **one**, **out** and **today**.

In Mathematics, the children have been learning about creating their own number problems. The children listened to the story 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' and drew pictures to help them work out Mr Gumpy's problem.
