Dear Parents and Carers.

Thank you to all of you who have already joined us this week for Parent Consultations. As ever it was great to talk to you and share how well your children are doing with us. We have had so many exciting learning opportunities since September to celebrate with you. We have received numerous positive comments regarding the option to select face to face or virtual sessions, so we do plan to keep this format moving forward (which came from parent feedback).

We also put our usual feedback opportunity via a Post-Its board inviting your comments about communication:

Work on our new community pool is continuing, including the laying of an access path through the school grounds and tiling of the changing rooms and pool hall. The community room is also now nearing completion. We are pleased so many of you are planning to visit during the pool open morning on 19th November. Please do pop along to see the progress that has been made. All are welcome anytime between 9.30am and 11am.

Unfortunately, despite the surveys undertaken and drainage pumps installed around the pool, ground water is proving to cause unforeseen delays to the installation of the fibreglass liner. A specialist contractor has now been appointed to investigate potential solutions in order that we can ensure that work can start on lining the pool as soon as possible. We will keep you updated as we have more news to share.



In the meantime, we look forward to welcoming you to the pool on 19th November.
