

# PE Report Autumn Term 2022

## PE Lessons:

All year groups have 1 indoor PE lesson and 1 outdoor lesson per week. Lessons follow the curriculum see website. We continue to follow 'Primary PE' for planning, progression and assessment.

Year 2-6 outdoor PE lessons delivered by class teacher with class TA if they have one and Mr. Williams our sports specialist.

## **Swimming Lessons:**

The swimming pool is due to open in January. Each class will be allocated a half term where they will have a block of 6-7 lessons, 1 per week.

This lesson will be in place of their indoor PE lesson.
