
If you would like to volunteer to help us on our trip could you please sign up on our sign-up sheet outside Willow Class. Please talk to a member of the Reception team if you have any questions.

Please help your child to practise blending CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words, e.g. peg, sam, dad, lip.
