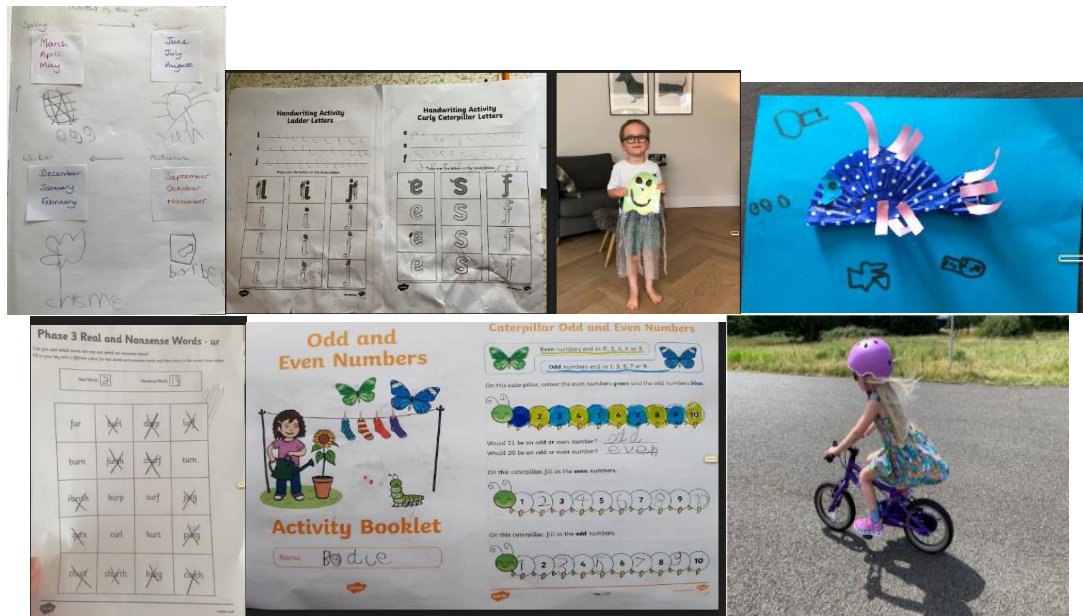
It is brilliant seeing all the creative and interesting learning everyone has been undertaking both at home and at school!
